Atascadero, CALIF. and Columbia Falls, MAINE (November 2, 2022) — Veterans of Foreign Wars (VFW) 2814 of Atascadero, CA announced today that it has chosen to support Wreaths Across America participating location Pine Mountain Cemetery in Atascadero as part of the national organization’s [Group Sponsorship Program](#).
